King Township Fibre Optic Broadband Expansion

King – November 3rd, 2017 marked the official first connection of the "King Township Fibre Optic Broadband Expansion" project as the first customer was connected to this state of the art broadband network.

Deb Schulte, Member of Parliament for King-Vaughan, on behalf of the Honourable Amarjeet Sohi, Minister of Infrastructure and Communities, Brian McCullagh, Director of Business Development at Vianet, Debbie Schaefer on behalf of Steve Pellegrini, Mayor of King Township, and Bob and Joan, the first customers to be hooked up were on hand to make that fibre optic connection.

This project is the start of a continued rural fibre optic build initiative to reach home and business owners that do not presently have access to wired broadband. The new Internet service will give these customers access to gigabit speeds without data caps and finally close the broadband gap that presently exists between urban and rural Ontario.

Construction began at the beginning of 2017 and is expected to be completed by the spring of 2019. This project will bring fibre-optic internet to more than 1000 homes, farms and businesses, providing speeds up to 1 Gigabit per second. This telecommunications infrastructure build was made possible with funding from the federal and provincial governments through the Small Communities Fund. Both the Government of Canada and the Government of Ontario contributed \$825,000 towards completion of the project. Vianet Inc. contributed an additional \$1.65 million dollars.
